- The first two steps planned for collaboration formation discussed at the Kick-off meeting were:
 - Step 1: Forming Institutional Board
 - Step 2: Forming a Charter Committee
- At the kick-off meeting we collected input from interested groups and have an (informal) list of 84 (!) Institutions that expressed interest in joining the forming EIC@IP6 collaboration (some stats are coming)
- These groups will form an initial Institutional Board for pre-collaboration to take part in the governance (if your name was listed as a contact person, please keep an eye on your email: we will confirm with you who will be the IB representative from your group and sign you up for the IB mailing list). This will complete initial phase of "Step 1" (tentatively – early next week).


