WG convener process

- □ Context
 □ We do not have a charter yet
 □ We do not have a voting body yet
 □ We have little time and need work to start ASAR

- ☐ What we need to start working:
 - ☐ At least 2 conveners for each of the WGs:
 - ☐ 4 on Physics Validation
 - 8 on Detector
 - ☐ 1 on Software

Convener Nomination process (part I)

- 1. Open call for nominations of all WG conveners
 - Submit nominations by Friday April 9, 11:59PM (EDT)
 - Will be done through a Google form :
 https://forms.gle/jzkrhG8ctNGGJhSK7
- 2. The list will be reviewed by the EIC@IP6 organizing committee shortly afterwards (availability check, agreement for a commitment, etc.)
- 3. In the meantime, a proto-IB will be formed (see Olga's talk)
- 4. A preliminary short list of conveners for each WG will be assembled by the organizing committee and sent to the proto-IB members early next week for ranking (see next slide)

Convener Nomination process (part II)

- 5. Each proto-IB member will be required to rank the pre-selected candidates and provide this feedback to the organizing committee. No quorum will be required.
- 6. The organizing committee composes the complete WG convener list based on the proto-IB input. It also makes sure the list is balanced in terms of the expertise as well as across the institutions and / or geographical areas and sends it back to the proto-IB for the final voting.
- 7. The proto-IB members vote on the proposed convener list as a whole. A simple majority of the submitted votes is required for the adoption.
- 8. The conveners will be contacted by the organizing committee to confirm their charge and length of appointment.

Your input on this process is welcome. This is an important step!
