



### Summer EICUG 2021 Meeting










# EICUG Demographics



### Charter Update

- In accordance with instructions laid out in the current Charter, an ad hoc committee was established in February 23, 2020 to review the EICUG Charter:

- Conducted a survey of EICUG membership in August 2020
- Main Conclusions:
  - Membership broadly satisfied with functioning of EICUG
  - O No consensus on changing conditions for membership at this time
  - Clear wish that EICUG act to enhance diversity and inclusion
