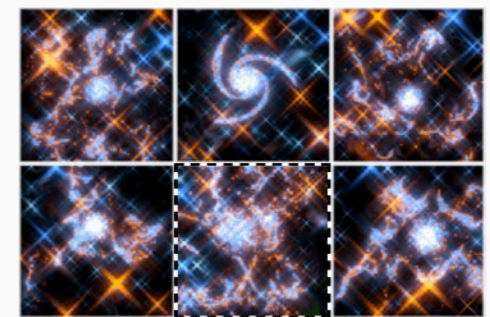

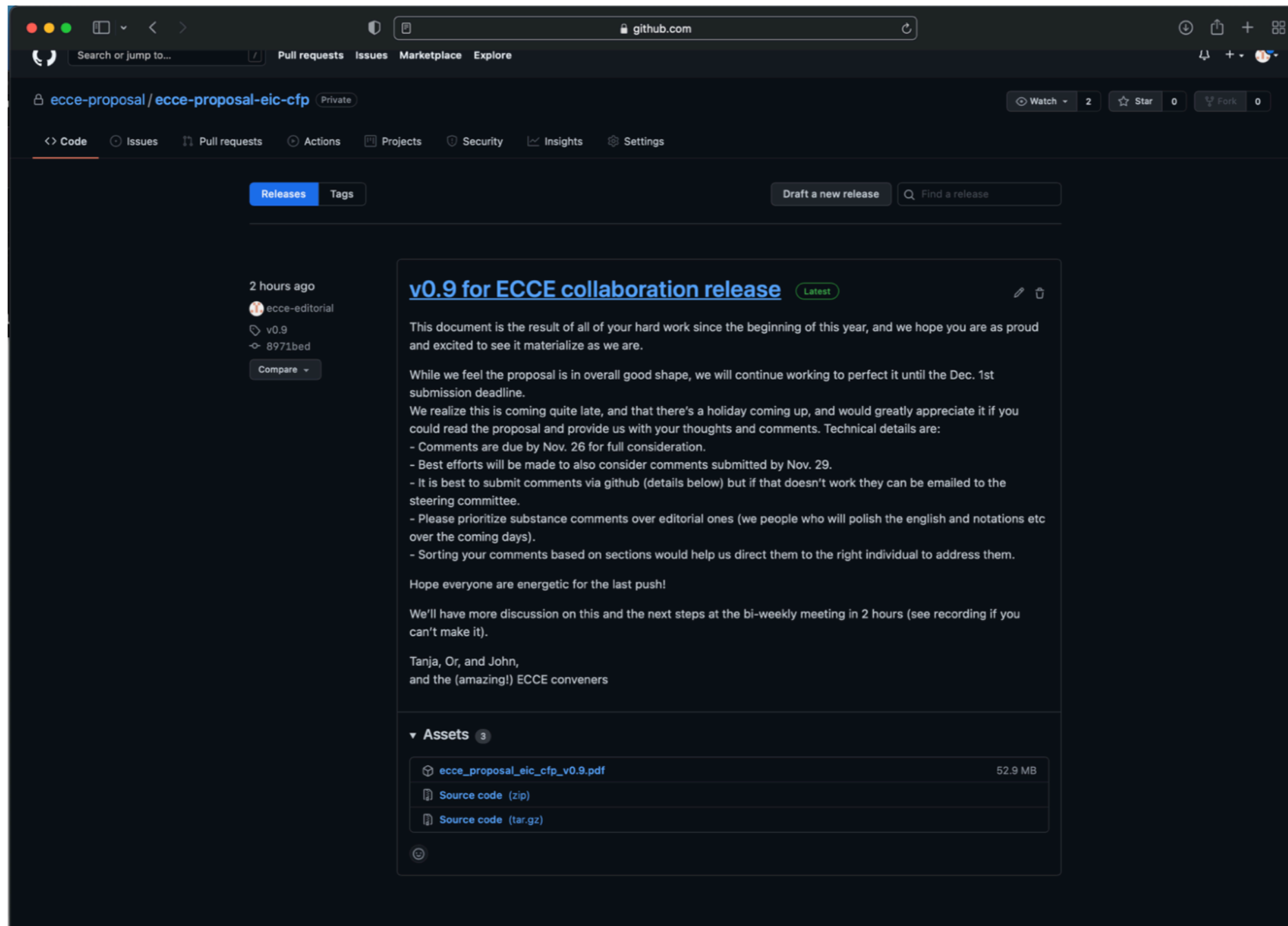

# To access proposal directly

- **Get a free GitHub account**
    - <https://github.com/join>
  - **Send your GitHub username to me ([steinberg@bnl.gov](mailto:steinberg@bnl.gov))**
    - I will add you to the list of proposal reviewers
  - **And then follow the simple instructions on the wiki**
    - [https://wiki.bnl.gov/eicug/index.php/ECCE Editorial](https://wiki.bnl.gov/eicug/index.php/ECCE_Editorial)
  - **This provides the best way for us to keep track of your comments and provide replies**
  - **Comments sent by email will also get posted (by us) on the GitHub release page, and replied there (and emailed back to you...)**
    - It's much easier for everyone if you let us know your GitHub name (& it's free), but we'll support you either way!
1. Start at the link sent for the particular release
  2. Look up a little click on "Issues"
  3. Click on the green "New Issue" button
  4. Add a title like "Richard Milner comments on v0.9"
  5. In the "write" section you can add your text comments
  6. Conversely (or in addition) you can just drag your PDF to the same window.
  7. Click on the green "submit new issue", and boom - an issue is submitted!
