

# **Tools and Services Activity Summary**

## **Overleaf**

- A limited number of licenses is available to programs who did not fund the original purchase. A process is in place to charge these programs for licenses used.
  - So far ~67 licenses granted to various organizations (mainly Physics and CSI)

## **Indico**

- Problem with CERN authentication via InCommon was solved on the Indico testbed, so we now have a viable pathway to migrate from local to federated identities. Next step is to write out a migration plan and submit it for approval by cyber and BHSO.

## **General Web Services**

- Elog service brought online for Phenix, currently migrating data from counting house and adjusting the settings for the future run.
- Reviewing and migrating to SDCC the development work done by external company (DataArt) on USATLAS website, standardizing the implementation along with further enhancements (Drupal, CERN plugins, SSO based on egroups etc)
- SDCC agreed to a proposal by Charity Plata to: 1) improve the new SDCC website organization and layout, and 2) update and improve readability of documentation of facility services. ETA for completion is the end of CY 2021.
- Development has begun on Phase II of BNL IBM/Q proposal submission application. Initial database design has been completed and currently wiring an existing proposal form to use the database.
