## Recent News on Indico

- ITD submitted a proposal to BHSO
  - Enable federated access on or about Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Disable creation of local accounts on or about Mar. 1st
  - Disable access via local accounts on or about June 1st
  - Accept federated access via BNL AD, SDCC, InCommon and EduGain (but not Google)
  - Option to link federated accounts with local accounts. This will help identify inactive
    accounts and those who cannot use federated accounts
- Legitimate users who cannot upload slides to BNL Indico otherwise may request SDCC (or AD) accounts, upon approval of a guest appointment
- Federated accounts a pre-requisite for other changes in authorization (ie, public vs. private pages) to ease access to Indico at BNL
- Meet next week to: 1) organize transition and post announcement, and 2) update ALD's

## BNLBox

- Announcement on new policy earlier this week resulted in significant feedback from user community
- Meeting next week to discuss policy ramifications and future directions (maybe refine it, but don't get your hopes up just yet)
- BOMs will be presented with an updated list of users
  - I sent announcement to user list as of August 31<sup>st</sup>—Ofer will generate a new list
  - Updated list will exclude inactive users (we found a few)
- In the meantime, please go to your BOM (Jim Desmond for NPP and Grace Giuffre for non-NPP users) to inquire about rates
  - BNLBox is an SDCC-operated service that is partly funded by CSI
  - Rate calculation is complex—BNL accounting rules require overhead for some accounts, and in-kind contributions are factored in for some users
