## WG5 - election policy proposal

- Election Committee: an ad-hoc committee set up for each election; 3 IB members nominated /self-nominated and then appointed by IB chair. Expect rotations for fair representation
- Major elections - IB chair(s) and Spokesperson(s)
- Minor elections: TBD - possible involvement with soliciting nominations for other TBD Standing Committees ?
- Voting: By IB members; electronic (secret) ballots. All votes must be announced four/two (?) weeks ahead of time and include specific details on how the voting will occur.
- Voting weights: proportional weights to group sizes. Possible scheme (a-la ATHENA): 1 vote per group + additional vote per every 10 (?) members
- DEI interface: involve DEI representative(s) into each nomination process
- Reporting: report to the Collaboration at each Collaboration meeting closest to the completed election


## WG5 - election policy proposal

- IB Chair elections:
- Nominations are solicited from the IB; candidates must be IB members
- Candidate statements to be shared with IB at least 2 weeks before election
- Virtual meeting with candidates?
- Election time/voting format to be announced at least 4 weeks ahead of the vote
- Simple majority of IB members voted
- Quorum: 50\% of IB (?)
- If more than 2 candidates:
- Ranked choice voting
- with no single candidates securing $50 \%$ threshold in the first round - run-off election for the 2 top candidates


## WG5 - election policy proposal

- Spokesperson/people:
- Nominations are solicited from the entire collaboration
- Candidate statements to be shared with collaboration at least 2 weeks before election
- Election time/voting format to be announced at least 4 weeks ahead of the vote
- Simple majority of votes
- Quorum: 50\% of IB (?)
- If more than 2 candidates:
- Ranked choice voting
- with no single candidates securing $50 \%$ threshold in the first round - run-off election for the 2 top candidates


## WG5 - policy proposal

- Not yet discussed by the WG5, but last moment thought based on STAR experience:
- High IB quorums are hard!
- We hope for an active and efficient IB, but should consider extra "incentives"
- Require participation from IB members - suspension of voting rights after 3 missed elections?
