# Election



- Per ePIC charter, **three** early-career representatives will be elected, **at least one** of which should be a graduate student.
- **Only early-career members may vote – the mailing list will be voting role sheet.**
- Unique and anonymous voting links will be sent the week after nominations
- Ranked-choice voting will be used:
  - Consider ranking at least one graduate student in top 3 to mirror charter requirement
  - If no graduate student candidate is ranked in top 3, highest-ranked graduate student will replace 3rd-ranked candidate
