Here is the minutes from today's meeting.

o ROC Status <Akitomo>

- **Cheng-Wei** provides RC-0S information
- **Jaein** will run his hot/dead channel finder code for sampled runs (1 run/week) and provide results to Akitomo. **Akitomo** will then evaluate the stability

o Schedule <Genki>

- South ROC install Feb.5 – Feb.19, North ROC Install Feb.19 – March 4.

o Preparation for Calibration Measurements <Genki>

- Testing the calibration in rcdaq is ongoing.
- ROC-18 will be back in as RC-0S instead of ROC-6 which has the TLK issue.
- Ground cables of ROCs are refurbished and now it is more robust. The team decided to remove 4 remaining ROCs to be removed from IR to change the ground cables.

o Software <Takashi>

- **Takashi** and **Wei-Che** will talk about the progress of the hot/dead map of cosmic runs.
- **Jaein** will prepare # of live channels vs. sigma cut.
- **Takashi** will ask for an advice from software group how to maintain online and offline parameters in a same database or separate database? Do we have official online parameter database?
- **Joseph** will report our plan and schedule in either tracking or software meeting.
