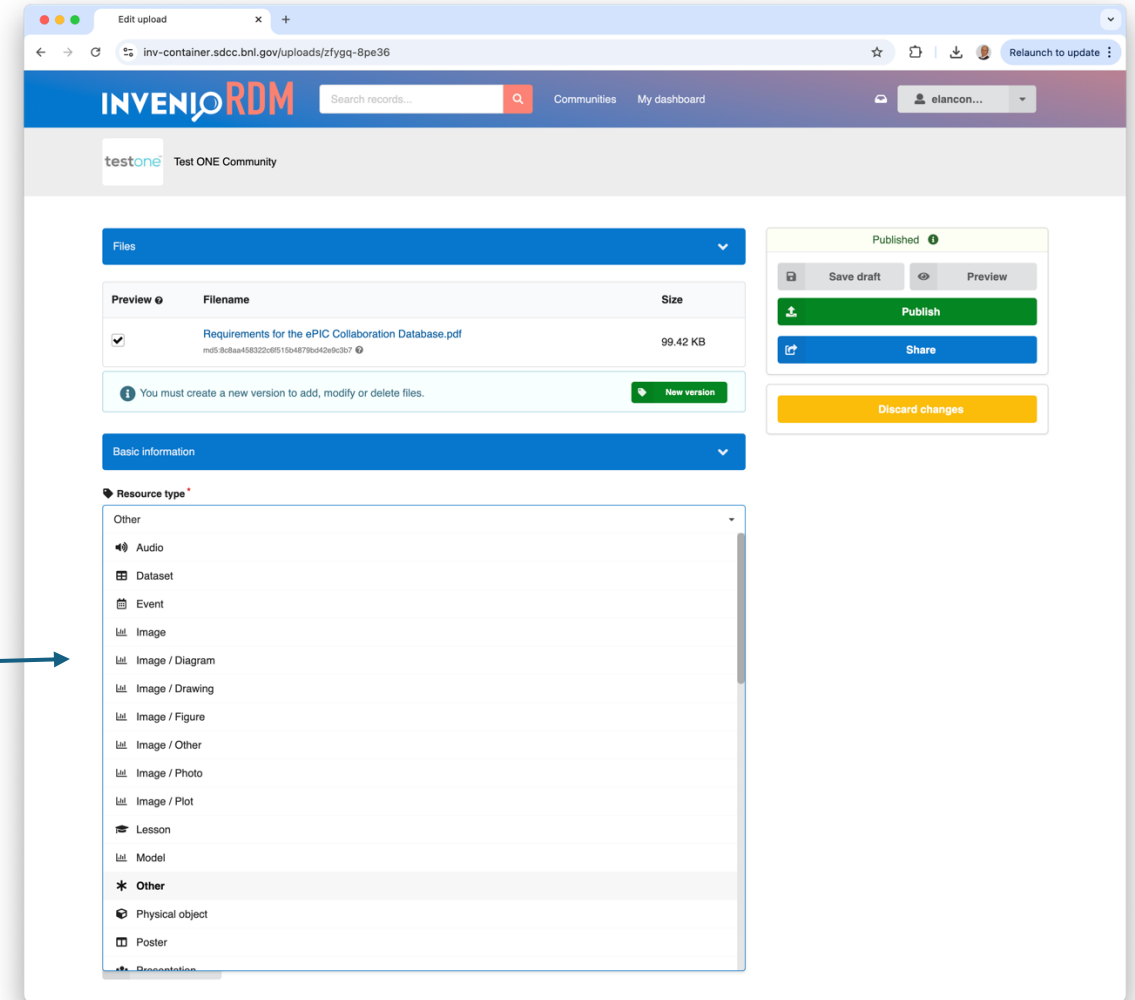

- Use ONE community to debug v12 prototype



# Roles within a given community

- **Standard Roles:** Defined within InvenioRDM.
- "Reviewer" role added specifically for sPHENIX.
- **Needs:**
  - **Reader Role:** Set as the default for all new community members. **How to implement restricted document within a community?**
  - **Role Assignment:** **Input from Peter/ePIC** needed for assigning Curator and Manager roles.
  - **Reviewer Role Clarification:**
    - Is the ability to edit required?
    - Can this role be limited to documents instead of the entire community? **Input from Peter/ePIC needed.**

Role	Access Level Permissions
Reader	A reader is a member of the community and can view restricted records owned by the community.
<i>Reviewer (Custom)</i>	<i>A Reviewer can in addition to a reader also edit and comment records in a community</i>
Curator	A curator can in addition to a reader also edit/accept/decline records in a community.
Manager	A manager can in addition to curators also manage members of a community.
Owner	An owner has full administrative access to a community, and can change all settings as well as delete the community.
