- We have continued to work with BNL management to address quality-of-life concerns.
- Some notable progress...

- Cavendish now has an entire co-ed (not restricted by gender) floor.
 - 3 men's bathrooms, 1 women's bathroom, 1 single-occupancy bathroom open to anybody
- Compton has 1 floor for women and 1 floor for men.
- Curie remains a women-only facility.
- Some improvements being made to privacy in shower areas – but still could be better.
- You can now request a female, male, or co-ed dorm room.
 - Women should probably specify whether they want to stay in Curie or not.
 - Women wishing to stay in Cavendish can reserve a co-ed room.
- Visitors are now allowed in Cavendish and Compton if accompanied by a resident.

- The Cafeteria has reopened.
- Uber drivers can now come onto the BNL site. Because this requires an escort, please allow for some extra time. You do not have to do anything to arrange the escort.
- Food delivery services can now also access the lab.
- The Home2 Suites hotel near the lab (by Wal-Mart) offers Government rates that Users can take advantage of. These rates fluctuate seasonally, but should represent a significant discount over the usual market rate. Please ask about this when booking. This hotel also offers shuttle service to the lab.


