
# pfRICH Mandrel Removal Plan

# Produce a cradle out of ratchet straps

Modification: Also mechanically secure endrings to the table



### Remove all wide panels

Rotate mandrel so panel is on top

Slide down supports and re-secure them

Detach foam

Slide out foam



#### Remove narrow panels


Add short 80-20 bars between the spokes of the frame

Rotate mandrel so panel is on the bottom

Place a long bar over the short bars on each side

Detach the panel from the frame

Lift the panel with ratchet straps and slide it out



#### All foam removed

Now deconstruct frame



#### Remove Shaft

The shaft can be supported by a long bar during removal



## The vessel will be removed from the table and stored vertically

We believe it will be manageable for 2 or 3 people to lift and rotate the vessel

It will be placed on a foam base and covered with plexiglass

The cradle will be left in place

The vessel can be placed back in the cradle for metrology or test fitting
