


Updates from PACs











- **Workfests at the Collaboration meeting in January**
 - A call for Workfests by John is already out
 - After discussion with the SPs and Coordinators, we plan to book a (half-day?) slot for a TDR+ESR dedicated parallel
 - We have noticed the same PWGs tend to propose parallels at every Collab. Meeting
 - **Option 1:** a longer all encompassing physics parallel with dedicated slots for each PWGs
 - **Option 2:** we try to organize worfests around defined technical tasks rather than PWGs
 - **Option 3:** we keep things as they are now

- TDR Ed.B. took a snapshot on Nov. 12 to discuss with PACs on Nov. 19
 - Please keep editing! The process continues till December. Let's keep the good momentum!
- October simulation campaign going well: started on 17th
 - Some issues have been, e.g. with the FF detectors being addressed by Alex
 - Markus, John and PACs agree to possibly use November campaign as a patch
 - November campaign will not have significant differences, other than fixes
 - **Prioritization of November campaign**: simulations affected by the **fixes** and **new simulations** will be prioritized the highest
- Results release Needs PWG approval, Analysis Note, code archived
 - First chance for presentation to the whole Collaboration is at the General Meeting of Dec. 5
 - Any PWG ready to release results by then (or by another time scale)?
 - Physics papers by the ePIC collaboration envisioned in 2026:
 - Early Science of exclusive+ diff PWG (early 2026)
 - Early Science Reports (Fall 2026)
 - Spin off from TDR chapter 4 (late 2026 / beginning 2027)
