

Meeting with PS/SPS Coordinator Martin Jaekel

- OH met with Martin at CERN on 11/24 to discuss ePIC beam requests
- PS (SPS) run time 2026 is 76% (68%) of 2025
 - SPS 2026 already 20% higher requests than 2025
 - As we all knew, 2026 would be tough.
- ePIC was designated "Recognized Experiment 47" status. This means nothing for test beams.
 - Technically ePIC beam requests are still bound by the rule of "outside experiments can request 2 wks PS + 1 wk SPS at maximum" which **applies to the entirety of ePIC.**
 - In practice Martin and the PS/SPS coordinators are understanding and supportive of ePIC requests but it is clear CERN experiments, DRD collaborations and further experiments approved by the SPS Council. Getting approval by SPSC will not be possible before 2026 run times.
- ePIC beam times have been at the mercy of the PS/SPS coordinators we need to be responsive and accommodating to get anything close to what we requested.
