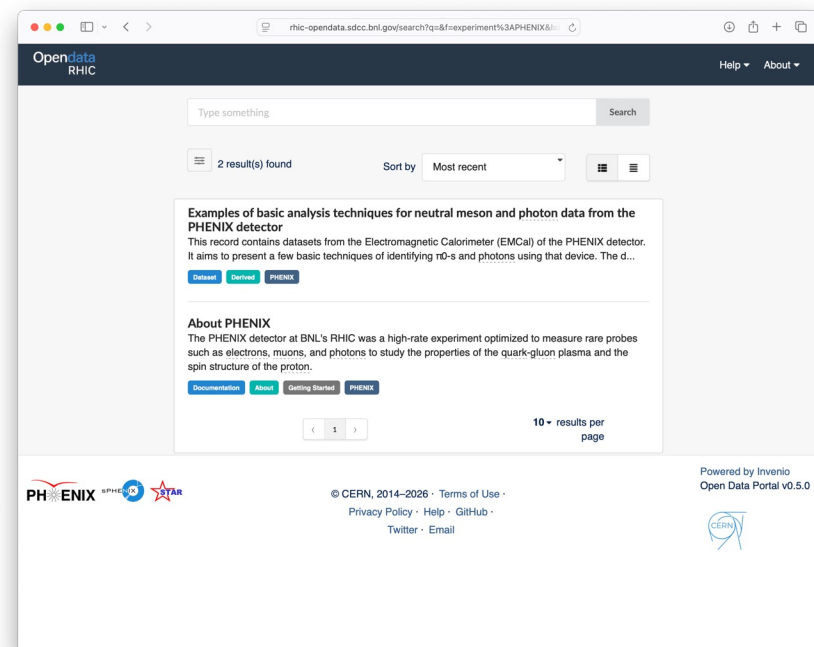
# Updates

- Two test RHIC repositories deployed
- Both repositories **now** accessible outside BNL (no VPN required)
- **Open Data repository** (CERN-like): for releasing datasets with documentation
- **InvenioRDM repository**: for records (notes, figures, etc.) with structured metadata
- Feedback requested: usability, access, functionality

# OpenData

- Contains PHENIX open data mirrored from CERN Open Data, preserving original DOIs

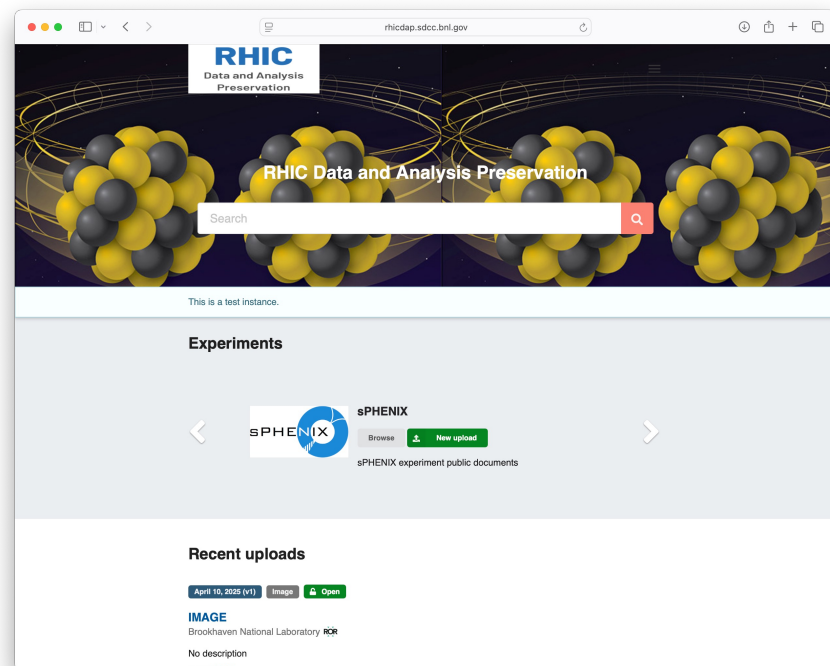

# Document repository – Features

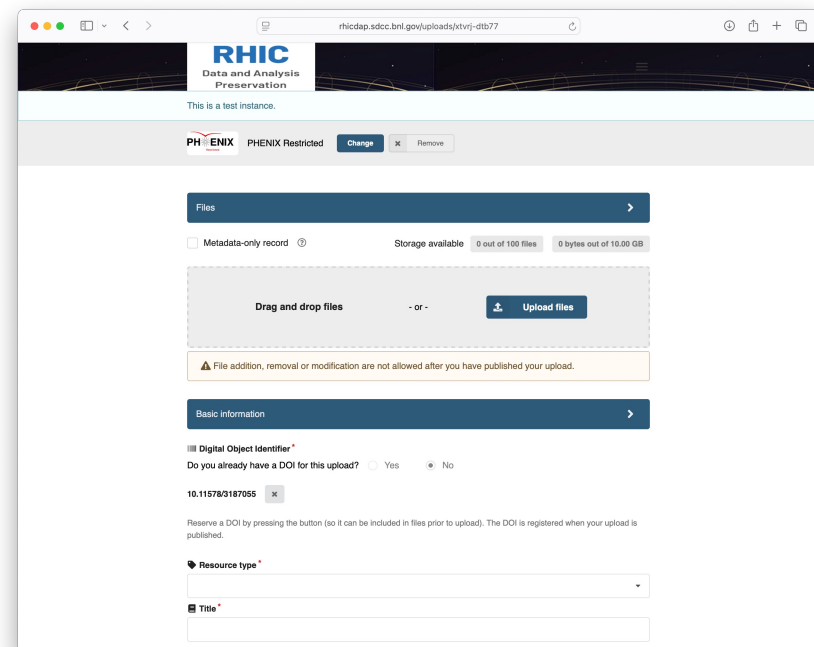
- Organized by experiment community (STAR, sPHENIX, PHENIX)
- Each community supports:
  - Public collections (open access)
  - Restricted collections (controlled access)
- Designed for:
  - Notes, documents and supporting material

# Access & Integration

- Federated login via CILogon
  - Uses institutional credentials (e.g. BNL, universities)
- Access control via Comanage (PhoneBook)
  - Manages group membership and permissions
  - Enables fine-grained control for restricted content
- Support DOI via OSTI
  - Ensures citability of records
